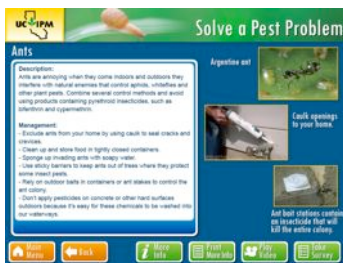


UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA IPM TOUCH-SCREEN KIOSK
